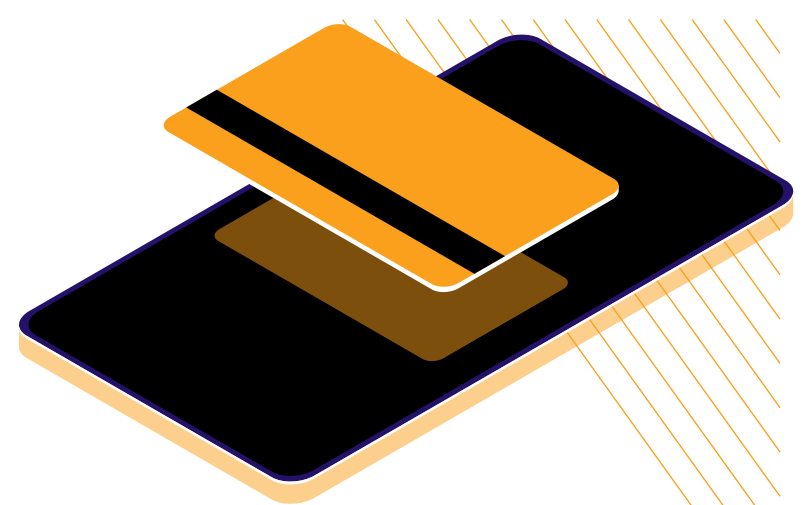
PCI DSS v4.0 is the next evolution of the payment security standard and will replace v3.2.1 with effect from March 31, 2024.

What are the key objectives of the standard?







Key goals of PCI DSS v4.0 –

-  Continue to meet the evolving security needs of the payments industry
-  Promote security as continuous process
-  Add flexibility for different methodologies
-  Enhance validation Methods







What are the major changes in v4.0?




Key changes from the previous version include –

-  Expanded multi-factor authentication requirements
-  Updated password requirements
-  Clearly assigned roles and responsibilities for each requirement
-  Targeted risk analyses at least once in every 12 months
-  Customized approach to design innovative controls that delves on outcome-based security
-  New requirements for merchants and service providers to set up incident response plans

What are the next steps for enterprises?

-  Evaluate the budgets, resources, and personnel against all the requirements
-  Conduct a gap analysis to understand the new processes and controls
-  Develop a roadmap of activities to be performed
-  Document the list of all the roles and responsibilities
